In 2019, our mission donated a new ultrasound machine to a medical clinic found in an impoverished landfill community. Ammy, an ultrasound tech, joined us in-field to teach the doctors and nurses in the clinic how to use the machine and how to make the most of it for the patients of the clinic.

Since, then, approximately 3500 ultrasounds have been offered to a community in need! All because of donors who gave generously toward a useful machine and a few people who were willing and excited to travel and train the professionals on the front lines.





In 2022, two Vital Signs Monitors were donated to the only public university in Guatemala, in an effort to help build a much needed SIM lab.



In just six semesters, hundreds of nursing students have had the opportunity to study cardiac monitoring in critical care patients and apply this hands-on training to their skillsets before heading into the workforce.
